Club must have active representation on the 4-H Association and the club must contribute significantly in county 4-H fund raising efforts and events. Money will be dispersed based on contributions made to county fund raising projects and events as well the merit of the proposal and long term effect of the project as well as the efforts of the club to raise funds on their own to contribute to the project. As mandated by USDA & IRS; all funds raised and properties acquired in the name of 4-H are the property of 4-H, not individuals in the club.
