Workmanship/Neatness (25 pts) Neat, well designed, good layout, good color scheme, portrays an image of 4-H, use of stickers/clip art, name of club on cover, securely bound	
Project or Activity (30 pts) Club/state activities, one service project, club presentations pictures labeled with captions (3 county/state events needed)	
Sense of Mastery (15 pts) List of club names, leaders and officers, the scrapbook tells a story of what the club is about. It shows the members having fun and learning about the project	
Club Story (20 pts) Gives a recap of the year, correct punctuation and grammar. Does the story tell of club involvement, club experiences and what the club has achieved throughout the year.	
Club Recognition (10 pts) Correspondence, brochures and programs, club award certificates and letters	
Bonus Points (up to 10) Club did extraordinary work in any field relating to activities, public speaking, leadership or community service
