



“Best 4-H Story” Contest



1. Any 4-H member in 4th – 13th grade (grade is based on grade completed not grade entering) who submits a record book can enter this contest. Member must submit two copies of the story. One copy goes in the completed record book and one is for the contest judging.
2. The story can be written in paragraph, poem, or other creative writing form.
3. Story should be well written using correct grammar, punctuation, vocabulary and spelling.
4. A photocopy of the story can be handed in as long as it is legible, and easy to read.
5. Member should include their name, age, grade, and club name on their story.
6. Story should be an overall summary of the current 4-H year. It should include what the member has learned and/or accomplished, and information about events and activities in which they have participated.
7. Story should include information about the project area(s) in which they have participated.
8. The story will be judged on the above criteria.
9. There will be one story selected as the “Best 4-H Story” for Jr. Division (grades 4-7) and one story selected for Sr. Division (grades 8-13).
10. The “Best 4-H Story” Award will be presented at Achievement Night.
11. The winner of the contest will be contacted in advance so they can be prepared to read their story at Achievement Night.
12. Story is due in 4-H office same date/time record books are due.
